In Matthew 4, Jesus tells Simon and Andrew to, "Follow me." This happens elsewhere with various people. Jesus is always asking people to, "Follow me." In Matthew 11, Jesus also says, "Come to me." It is really quite astonishing to think of these simple phrases, "follow me," and, "come to me." The God of all creation comes to simple fishermen and people like you and says, "Hey, I want you to be with me."

Why?

Jesus' desire is to stand with you to take His work and make it your work and also to take your work and make it His work. That is what the passage in Matthew 11 is all about. Jesus wants to take our filthy rags, our ugliness before God, our sin, and our shame and make them His own. In exchange, He wants to give you His perfect record, His beauty before God, and His very own righteousness.

This exchange is beautiful for us and for Jesus because it brings glory to Jesus. Also, when we believe that this is what Jesus does, this is what we receive. The Christian's faith doesn't say, "I am so great," or, "I can get better." At least, that is not what the Bible says. Instead, the Christian's faith says, "I know in whom I have believed. His name is Jesus. And He has put away my sin." And the beautiful thing about our sin being put away is that it is completely finished upon the cross. This was done for you.
